**VISITING A BEXLEY FOODBANK**

From Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022, all clients will now need to bring bags with them when attending the foodbank. If you arrive with no bags then unfortunately we will be unable to help you with food. You will be advised to return to the foodbank once you have suitable means to get the food to your home.

**There will be no exceptions to this policy.**

All clients should try to ensure that they arrive at least 15 minutes before the foodbank closing time.

All the staff are volunteers who have generously given their time to help run the foodbanks within Bexley and ensure that this service is available on a regular basis to those in need.

We ask that you treat all foodbank staff with respect.

Abusive/Aggressive behaviour towards any member of foodbank staff is unacceptable and will result in the police being informed and may also lead to you being banned from all foodbanks within the Bexley area.
