Crossrail South-East – March Work Update

Network Rail is undertaking work in your area as part of the Crossrail Programme, linking Reading and Heathrow in the west to Shenfield and Abbey Wood in the east, via new tunnels under central London.

Following on from our previous letter please find some further information regarding forthcoming work in your local area.

We will be carrying out most of our work during normal daytime hours but due to safety reasons some of our work has to be carried out whilst trains are not running. This means carrying out work during the night and at weekends. Work planned to take place in March is as follows:

<u>Harrow Manorway Way.</u> Demolition of the concrete central pedestrian ramp adjacent to the road.	Saturday 28 March 01:15 until Monday 30 March 04:10
<u>Between Church Manorway and Bostall Manor Way.</u> Works will involve laying concrete troughs, building line side walkways, installing services below the tracks and laying drainage.	Saturday 7, 14, 21, 28 March 13:00 – 18:00 Sunday 8, 15, 22, 29 March 09:00 – 17:00
<u>Church Manorway north</u> there will be an installation of replacement pipe sections into live drainage system. A gully sucker tanker will be positioned outside of 139 Church Manorway to pump access water flow.	Midweek Nights 9, 10, 11, 12 March 23:00 – 06:00

<u>South of 47 Mottisfont Rd</u> there will be an installation of replacement pipe sections into the live drainage system. A gully sucker tanker will be positioned outside of 51 and 53 Bracondale Road to pump access water flow.	Midweek Nights 23, 24, 25, 26 March 23:00 – 06:00
<u>Between Crossrail tunnel entrance and Mottisfont Road</u> works will consist of removal of sheet piles and laying deep drainage during the closure of the North Kent Line.	Sunday 8 March 08:00 – 20:00 Saturday 21 March 00:00 to Monday 23 March 02:00 Saturday 28 March 08:00 – 20:00
From the start of the <u>Crossrail tunnel entrance to Eynsham Drive</u> repositioning the rails on the North Kent lines	Weekday Nights 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 March 23:00 – 06:00
<u>Eynsham Drive</u> Works will consist of unloading sleepers.	Weekend Nights 21, 22, 23 March 01:05 – 04:00
Between <u>Crossrail tunnel entrance to Eynsham Drive</u> Unloading track ballast from the discharge train	Sunday 29 March 01:05 until Monday 30 March 05:00
<u>From Crossrail tunnel entrance to Eynsham Drive</u> Unloading top stone onto the railway	Weekend/weekday Nights 28, 29, 30, 31 March and 1, 2, 3 April 23:00 – 06:00
