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Bexley secures 'Keep Me Posted' recognition

Bexley has been recognised by the 'Keep Me Posted' campaign for the way it keeps in touch with residents.

The Council has joined other councils, utilities and financial service companies, in showing support for the campaign, that aims to give consumers the choice of how they receive their bills and statements.

Bexley already meets the three conditions of offering council tax payers paper bills and statements -

- Without imposing charges or other penalties
- Without removing or changing frequency unless there has been prior consultation
- Without taking away continued access to online.

Leader of the Council, Cllr Teresa O'Neill OBE said; "We recognise that online is generally quicker and easier for most people nowadays, but we also know that there are a number of people who prefer to receive their information by post. We hope that by making our commitment to the 'Keep me posted' campaign, we can reassure our residents that we will continue to communicate with them in the way that's best for them."
