Highway issues? Report them by app

Bexley is now using FixMyStreet to make it easier for you to report a range of highways and street issues.

The change makes self-service easier and will show you the status of the issue you raise.

You can use FixMyStreet to report around 18 issues that previously had to be reported using an online form –

- Abandoned vehicles
- Animal fouling
- Cars for sale on the highway
- Dead animals
- Fly-posting
- Glass and debris
- Graffiti
- Grass cutting and weeding
- Highways defects
- Obstructions on the highway
- Parks and open spaces
- Public conveniences
- Utility equipment

If you sign up for notifications, you will be notified of the Council's response.

The FixMyStreet app is ideal for reporting incidents when you are out and about, using the camera built into your smart device. It is available to download free of charge for Android and Apple devices.
