## Night time resurfacing works Harrow Manorway

A major work programme at Harrow Manorway will end in December. Some minor finishing works such as landscaping will be completed in early 2020.

As the works enter the final stages resurfacing will take place overnight for 4 nights from Tuesday 29 October to Friday 1 November.

Diversions will be in place from 7pm onwards at the following locations;

- **Tuesday 29 October and Wednesday 30 October - 7pm to 2am**

Resurfacing work will take place at Sainsbury's roundabout at the junction of Lensbury Way/Harrow Manorway. The roundabout will be closed in all directions. Traffic will be diverted via Knee Hill, Abbey Wood Road, Abbey Road, Gilbert Road, Lower Road, Picardy Manorway and Yarnton Way.

There will be no entry to the Sainsbury's car park. Vehicles that are already parked in the store car park will be able to exit however this may take longer than normal.

The section of road outside Sainsbury's will remain open and accessible for traffic travelling from Abbey Wood station. Drivers will be able to access Overton Road, the BP garage and the front of Sainsbury's. Sainsbury's and the BP garage will be open as usual.

Special access will be provided for residents in Lensbury Way from the Eynsham Drive/Yarnton Way roundabout.

- **Thursday 31 October and Friday 1 November - 7pm to 2am**

Work will take place to resurface Harrow Manorway northbound between the Harrow Manorway/Yarnton Way roundabout and just before the Harrow Manorway/Ampleforth Road access. Traffic will be diverted via Yarnton Way and Eastern Way. Access to Godstow Road/Sewell Road will be maintained via Eynsham Drive and Grovebury Road.

As far as is practically possible, noisy operations will end around 11pm and all works will finish no later than 2am. The road will reopen a couple of hours later, depending on the time it takes for the surface to harden and weather conditions.
